## PUPPY RAISER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Puppy Raisers must be at least 15 years of age or team with an adult and must reside in California.
- Basic Canine Rights Read and Practice.
- 3. Puppy Raisers love, play with and socialize our puppies. Letting them be beautiful puppies and exploring their world as they learn everything is amazing! A confident, happy puppy is an important goal. We want our Puppy Raisers to snuggle and love the puppies up as if they were their own, creating confident service dogs.
- 4. All Raisers are required to attend the Virtual Tuesday, PUPPY MEETUPS 12:15-1:15 pm PT on ZOOM.US.
- 5. Post weekly photos, training videos, and a diary of your experiences in Mobility Service Dogs' Facebook Private Group.
- 6. Fill out an online evaluation form with a questionnaire, due on the 3rd of every other month.
- 7. First Saturday of every month, 10-2 rotate between Brookside Park, Pasadena, and Huntington Central Park, Huntington Beach. 10-12 hands-on training sessions, 12-1 Picnic Lunch supplied by MobilityDog, and 1-2:30 additional training and practice. Dog food and new tools for training are picked-up at the First Saturday.
- 8. Puppy Raisers Evaluation check-ins will be weekly with the Service Dog Trainer you are working with; it is the Puppy Raiser's and MobilityDog trainer's responsibility to calendar time for these training and assessments.
- 9. Puppy Raisers receive dog food, toys, and treats—you cover all grooming, travel expenses, and non-approved veterinary care. We cover vaccines and neutering. (\*Travel expenses refer to your personal traveling adventures when you include your Service Dog in Training and bring the SDiT back to Pasadena for formal training.)
- 10. We ask ALL MobilityDog Community volunteers to set fundraising goals each year! Birthday Party is the First Saturday in February, and Poodle Palooza is the First Saturday in October each year.
- 11. Upload and keep current paperwork for your Service Dog in Training in the Puppy Portal.
- 12. Raise the service dog in training (SDiT) until 18 months or when it is called to the SD trainer for transitioning.
